Sub: TSBIE -Academic- 75th Anniversary of Independence Day - "Swathantra Bharatha Vajrotsava Dvisaptahamu Celebrations" in all Junior Colleges in the State - Activities to be conducted - Reg.

All the Principals of Junior Colleges and Composite Colleges offering Intermediate Course in the State are informed that the Government of Telangana has decided to celebrate the 75th Anniversary of our Independence Day as part of "Swathantra Bharatha Vajrotsava Dvisaptahamu Celebrations" from 08th to 22nd August 2022. It is ordered to take up different activities like involve local elected representatives, decoration of colleges, singing of patriotic songs on Vajrotsava Vanamahotsavam, Mapping of students and theatres for viewing of Gandhi Movie, conduct of sports for 'Freedom Cup' and distribution of prizes. The celebrations will commence from 08th August to 22nd August. The dates of the program and day wise activities are detailed in the enclosure.

All these programs shall be conducted at each and every Junior College without fail and within the jurisdiction of the TSBIE by the Principal of respective Junior Colleges and concerned Principal shall take care/responsibility of children. The management shall have no room for complaints and act of non-performance will be viewed seriously. However, daily and weekly reports shall be submitted to the concerned DIEO/Nodal Officer. Organizing committee consisting of Principal and Senior Lecturers should be formed to supervise the conduct of the celebrations. Further, the programme should be prepared in advance and has to be communicated to the DIEO/Nodal Officer concerned. The DIEOs / Nodal Officers should inspect some colleges every day and should participate in the programme. Some Observers will be sent from the Head Office to oversee the conduct of celebrations.

Therefore, the college management are hereby requested to follow the instructions/ dates of the program and day wise activities mentioned in the enclosure Without fail.

Tentative Schedule & details of day wise activities

As part of Swathantra Bharatha Vajrotsava Dvisaptahamu celebrations in All Junior Colleges, the following activities shall be conducted in both Government/Government Sector/Aided/Private Un-Aided Junior Colleges:-

- **Decoration of Junior Colleges :** On 10th of August all the Junior Colleges shall be decorated with colour papers, mango leaves, rangoli etc. to mark the beginning of Swatantra Bharata Vajrotsava Celebrations at Junior Colleges. The premises shall be adorned with Rangoli every day. This festive decoration and atmosphere shall continue till the 22nd August, 2022.
- **One Patriotic Song :** In addition to the Vandemataram prayer song, one patriotic song from the list of songs annexed may be played in the assembly **every day** using public address system (Mic set)..(18 Patriotic songs list enclosed at Annexure -II).
- **Arrangements:** Public address system shall be arranged in all Junior Colleges for conduct of activities, related to this program.
- **Vajrotsava Vanamahotsavam :** On 10th August, atleast 75 plants shall be planted in every Junior Colleges by students.
- **Saamuhika Jaateeya Geetalapana:** On 11th August, throughout the state of Telangana, there shall be synchronized singing of the national anthem at the pre-determined time.
- **Viewing of Gandhi Movie:** As per the schedule given by the District Authorities, children may be sent for viewing of the movie **Gandhi** in movie theatres specified in the schedule.
- **'Freedom cup' titled Games & sports:** Games and sports activities shall be conducted at Junior Colleges.
- **Prizes:** The students who secure 1st and 2nd position in all the competitions mentioned below, may be awarded prizes and certificates on 22nd of August at Junior Colleges. All events / prizes / mementos shall be named with a pre-fix of the word, **"Freedom"**. Eg. Freedom Cup.
